

## Position Opening

Immanuel Baptist Church in beautiful Vancouver, BC, Canada, is looking for a new Senior Pastor. Immanuel Baptist is a 53 year old church with a combined average attendance around 150 ([www.immanuelbc.ca](http://www.immanuelbc.ca)). It is evangelical in theology and is affiliated with the North American Baptist Conference ([www.nabconference.org](http://www.nabconference.org)) and the British Columbia Association of the NABC ([www.bcnabc.ca](http://www.bcnabc.ca)). Planted by German immigrants to Canada, it is today a multi-cultural and multi-national church that reflects the growing city of Vancouver. On Sundays you will find three separate but united congregations meeting in an English-language worship service, a Korean worship service and a German-language worship service. Combined worship services in the English language are also held on a regular basis. There is also a Chinese Fellowship (Mandarin/Cantonese) that meets on a monthly basis. The immediate church neighbourhood is 59% Asian ethnic or Pacific Island in origin. Immanuel is looking for God's man who will preach and teach the inerrant Word of God with authority, help people develop a passion for Jesus while growing in their faith, shepherd the diverse flock of God known as Immanuel, build bridges across diverse cultures and age groups, do the work of an evangelist while training others to share the Gospel, and lead the church into a new era of ministry to a culturally diverse neighbourhood and city. Immanuel is completing a two-year term in December with an Intentional Interim Pastor who has assisted the church in preparing for its next Senior Pastor.
